cheap	[tʃi:p]
expensive	[ɪk'spensɪv]

Is <i>this pen</i> cheap?	Yes, <i>this pen</i> is cheap .
Are <i>these shoes</i> expensive?	Yes, <i>these shoes</i> are expensive .
Is <i>this pencil</i> expensive?	No, <i>this pencil</i> isn't expensive , but it's cheap .
Is a big car cheap?	No, a big car isn't cheap , but it's expensive .

a.m.	[eɪ em]
p.m.	[pi: em]
noon	[nu:n]

It's 3 a.m. (= before noon). It's 5 p.m. (= after noon).

What's the time?	It's 10 a.m. or: It's 4 p.m.
Is it 10 p.m. ?	No, it isn't 10 p.m. , but it's 10 a.m.
Is it 4 a.m. ?	No, it isn't 4 a.m. , but it's 4 p.m.
What time is noon?	Noon is at 12 p.m.
Do we have our lesson at noon?	Yes, we have our lesson at noon . or: No, we don't have our lesson at noon .



What's the time?
~ It's 10 a.m. or: It's 4 p.m.
