

A Flying Boat

An unusual race happened in France last week. Athletes raced in 'flying boats' which were boats that were powered by **pedaling**.

Nicolas Picard started the company JetCycle in 2020, but the idea of a flying boat came from two French professors in 2013. Picard explained that using a JetCycle boat looked like boat cycling. Then he put **foil** in the front and at the back, which made the boat fly. The boat could move at the speed of around 9 kilometers per hour.

Picard hopes that people will enjoy this new activity, which **combines** sailing and cycling. One boat costs 12,000 euros, and Picard wants to sell 100 boats in the next three years.

Difficult words: **pedal** (to use your legs and feet to move a bicycle), **foil** (a piece of very thin material), **combine** (to put two or more things together to make one thing).
