

The World's Heaviest Strawberry

A farmer in Israel grew the world's heaviest strawberry. The strawberry was 18 centimeters long, and it weighed 289 grams, which was about five times more than a normal strawberry.

Cold weather was the reason why the strawberry grew so big. It didn't **ripen** quickly, and it kept growing bigger and bigger. The man saw how big the strawberry was, and he thought that it could be a new world record. When he **harvested** the fruit, he put it in the freezer, and he waited for a message from the Guinness World Records. When he knew that he won, he took the fruit out of the freezer, and he showed it to everyone.

The **previous** world record strawberry grew in Japan in 2015, and it weighed 250 grams.

Difficult words: ripen (when fruit becomes ready to eat), **harvest** (to pick the fruit when it is ready to eat), **previous** (the one before the last).
