B: **Who's in it?**

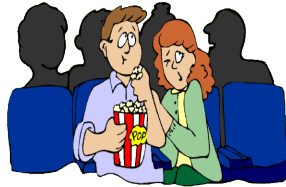
A: It's Starring Misha Colling, Torri Higginson and Peter Wingfield.
