Read the Passage

Many researchers believe that our governments have acquired extra-terrestrial technology through alien vehicles which have crashed on Earth. The 1947 incident at Roswell New Mexico – in which the US military first admitted it had acquired a "flying disk" from a crash site, and then denied it the next day. There are persistent stories, for example, that U.S. President Eisenhower actually met an alien ambassador at Edwards Air Force Base in 1954. What is clear, however, is that if they are a fake, they are an extraordinarily impressive one. A huge amount of time and effort must have gone into researching and preparing them.
