Supporting Arguments:



POSITION ONE: Prostitution should be legalized.

Regulating the industry should result in safer working conditions for prostitutes.

The government is missing out on a lot of uncontrolled tax.

Having stricter control in place should help reduce the spread of sexually transmitted diseases.

A proper training program could be introduced to improve the service.



Supporting Arguments:

POSITION TWO: Prostitution should remain illegal.

Legalizing prostitution would only serve to further morally corrupt society.

Legalizing prostitution would encourage more men to cheat on their wives.

Prostitution increases the risks of sexually transmitted diseases.

Prostitution is linked to many other crimes.

It gives the police something to do when they are bored.
